HAVE YOU HEARD OF FRIENDS AND HEROES?

It's a presentation of old and new testaments bible stories, scheduled for broadcast on CBBC (available on Freeview, Cable and Satellite).

So what is Friends and Heroes about? Set in the first century AD, Friends and Heroes retells Bible stories that are being 'passed on' by early believers. So, children will hear Bible stories in a lively and engaging way, and they'll also find out about the people who helped to change the world, simply by being friends and becoming heroes.

When? The scheduling by the BBC means that children in the UK could be the first in Europe to see these stories. The plans, subject to change, are to broadcast all **13 episodes on weekdays between 12th and 23rd March**; sometimes two episodes a day starting at 12 noon and 12.30, or a single episode starting at 12.30.

Lesson plans and pupil worksheets are available for teachers There are 13 lesson plans which have been created to complement the national syllabus guidelines for ages 7-11 throughout the UK. These lessons (in PDF format) will be available to download from 12 March. And you can print off as many as you need for your class to use.
