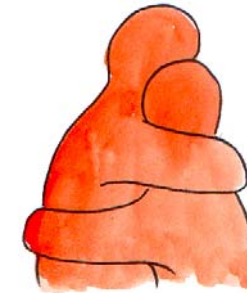
If this sounds interesting, please contact Pat Oakley. You will be very welcome.
