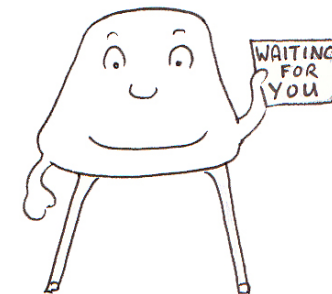

TRINITY NEW BUILD APPEAL 2008

We are delighted to announce that at the end of the official month of pledging towards our direct giving target of £250,000 for this next year of fund-raising for our church re-building, the amount of money pledged to be given by members and friends over the next 12 months now totals £100,390. This is an encouraging result, especially in these uncertain times, and we thank the Lord for providing and inspiring his people to step out in faith to give.

The number of responses to our appeal so far totals 83, so there are clearly many who have yet to respond. If you are still considering making a response to our appeal, please note that there is no time limit and you can do so at any time to Geoff Bell, Andrew Barnes or Vanessa Edmonds, although we would encourage you to make your response within the next 3 months so that the TNB team can plan progress of the project wisely.

If you have pledged a *weekly amount* - please see Jennifer Lanstone for Building fund dated envelopes. If you have pledged a *monthly amount* - the easiest way is to set up a standing order. There are yellow forms in the rack under the pigeonholes; half of the form goes to your bank, the other half to Andrew Barnes. If you prefer not to do this, proceed as for lump sums. If you have pledged a *sum in several instalments* or a *lump sum* - put the cash or cheque in an envelope and mark it Trinity New Build.
