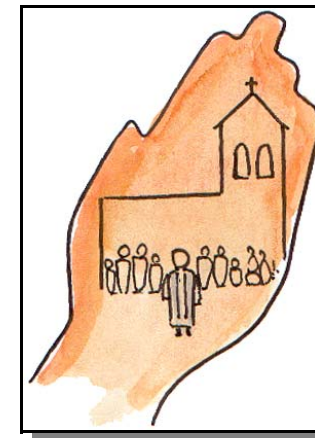
A Message from Jack
