**TRINITY NEW BUILD – APPEAL 2010** The second year of our church fundraising for our Trinity New Build project has now started and we invite all members and friends to consider their prayerful response to the challenge of our next year of direct giving to our church rebuilding project – with a key target of raising another £160,000 within this year 2010. In a church of 250 members this is equivalent to £1.75 per member per day. We are looking to raise this sum directly from personal contributions - either as one-off donations, or as donations spread over the next year (on a monthly basis or in any other way convenient to you).

Our project funds currently stand at around £184,000 and we aim to reach over £340,000 by January 2011, at which level we can engage the direct support of our Methodist Connexion in finding further funding, to help take us on towards our ultimate overall project target of £1.35million. Please consider prayerfully your response to this 2010 appeal, and reply using the pledge forms distributed at services this weekend. Forms will also be available from the church office. We invite your completed forms to be returned on our special Gift Sunday on 31st January.
